Carey gets real estate licence back

Western Australia's real estate industry watchdog has failed to stop the head of the failed property group Westpoint regaining his licence.

The Real Estate Agent Supervisory Board appealed a decision to allow Norm Carey to renew his licence.

The board argued he was not a fit and proper person.

WA's Court of Appeal has rejected the board's challenge, which means Mr Carey is able to get his licence back.

Westpoint collapsed in 2006 leaving hundreds of creditors about \$300 million out of pocket.
